

At the heart of national ambition, the Paris-Saclay agglomeration,
home to 320 000 residents and 26 000 companies,
accounts for 8.5% of public and private researchers and ranks
among the world's eight leading innovation hubs.*

At Paris-Saclay, we believe that complexity is the DNA of our ever-changing world, and our “science-innovation-business” ecosystem empowers us to stay ahead of major transitions. To tackle this challenge, we are rolling out a new economic strategy in support of impact-driven companies, built on three pillars:

1. ambitiously driving the ecological transition of businesses;
2. accelerating the transformation of business models through enhanced adoption of digital tools and artificial intelligence;
3. embedding these initiatives within an inclusive strategy that ensures economic opportunities for all.

In an era marked by ecological, digital, and societal transformations, this refreshed strategy is designed to solidify Paris-Saclay’s position as a robust, sustainable, and inclusive innovation hub.

The Paris-Saclay agglomeration is placing ecological transition at the heart of its own development, and its own local companies. Among the priority initiatives, implemented in collaboration with our public-private partners, are:

- densifying, enhancing usage, and decarbonizing the four key hubs: Massy, Campus Urbain, Courtabœuf, and Portes d’Orly;
- strengthening our offering for artisans and businesses by providing a complete and efficient residential course;

- establishing a territorial land in partnership with Caisse des Dépôts to support commercial and business real estate;
- equip ourselves with a specific mission responsible for defining our ambition for digital sovereignty in the light of transitions.



With nearly 320 000 residents, the Paris-Saclay Urban Community, together with Saint-Quentin-en-Yvelines and Versailles Grand Parc, is part of a major national initiative. Within this dynamic, bold, and thriving ecosystem, the agglomeration offers a wide array of opportunities, from urban campuses near Orly and the vibrant Massy business park to the Courtabœuf Regional Hub, which hosts over 23 000 jobs.



Paris-Saclay: a territorial ecosystem connected to Paris and the World

Grégoire de Lasteyrie, Mayor of the City of Palaiseau, is the President (Chairperson) of Paris-Saclay Local Authority, a French intercommunality ("Communauté d'agglomération"). This is a public body for inter-municipal cooperation which coordinates the administrative functions of 27 town councils in our region. The team of the President is based on 15 Vice-presidents and 11 delegates of the president.

Paris-Saclay Authority operates in a two-tier system, meaning there is Paris-Saclay Assembly Council (78 local elected officials), which is responsible for certain services across the whole intercommunality (economic development, spatial planning, mobility, tourism, waste, etc.) and 27 cities, responsible for different services in the areas they cover.

The Paris-Saclay Local Authority covers 186 sq.km.

At Paris-Saclay, we continuously push the limits of business by merging research, innovation, and the economic sphere. Our companies in six strategic sectors work in synergy to transform cutting-edge research into tangible solutions.



Healthcare and Biotechnology

With leading names like **FB, Servier, Biolabs, Oncodesign, Eurofins, and Eurobio**, Paris-Saclay is at the forefront of health innovation. Our ecosystem features **146 startups and 346 laboratories** driving breakthroughs in the microbiome, gene therapy, oncology, and connected health.



Aerospace, Defense and Cybersecurity (NewSpace)

Key players like **Onera, Exotrail, Trust Me, Thales, Winms, Hemeria, Weeroc, and Nucleudes** are driving the NewSpace revolution and cybersecurity innovation. Our community includes **16 startups and 68 laboratories** transforming aerospace and defense.



Agro-food and Bioeconomy

Danone Nutricia Research, Carrefour, and Umiami position Paris-Saclay as a leader in sustainable solutions for food and agriculture. Here, **77 startups and 110 laboratories** are pioneering the future of food, nutrition-based health, and smart agriculture.



Mobility and Transportation

With trailblazers such as **Utac and Faar Industrie**, Paris-Saclay is emerging as a hub for mobility innovation. The sector hosts **12 startups and 46 laboratories** developing autonomous vehicles, hydrogen technologies, and advanced embedded systems.



Energy and Environment

With innovators such as **IPVF, Elogen, Adionics, Vaisala, and EDF Lab**, the energy transition is at the heart of our ecosystem. This dynamic sector is powered by **47 startups and 123 laboratories** advancing energy storage, biofuels, and smart grid technologies.



Digital Technologies/ AI-Driven Communication

Featuring industry leaders like **Kuka, Essilor, Nanoe, Isybot, ASN, Nokia, Ericsson, Quandela, Data4, Pasqal, and Ivalua**, Paris-Saclay is at the cutting edge of artificial intelligence, quantum technologies, the Internet of Things, and smart manufacturing. This sector is fueled by **106 startups and 252 laboratories**, all at the forefront of digital innovation.

Paris-Saclay is a key player on the International Stage. Not only does Paris-Saclay shine in academic and scientific fields, but it also stands out thanks to its world-class innovation and R&D facilities and its high density of deeptech companies.





Strane Innovation is a nonprofit research enterprise tackling four major challenges of sustainable development. One project, “Bluemapping,” is the first solution capable of modeling rainwater runoff with unparalleled precision at various scales. The agglomeration is even piloting Bluemapping’s ultra-fast modeling to design more sustainable and resilient neighborhoods.

As Alexandre emphasizes: “Runoff is everywhere, not just in France, but across Europe and the world. Addressing this challenge is a global priority”.


